

**Electronic Portfolio: All About Me**  
Final Project  
(Due no later than May 20, 2010; Semester ends June 1, 2010)



**All links must work before uploading to think.com!**

**Instructions:** Save all files from think or edmodo before deleting them for editing!!! Once edited, copy all files that will be attached to your project to a folder with your name and class period. Make sure links work and **sources are cited**. Let me know before you upload file to think.com. Create a compressed zipped file for your portfolio. Folder should have your name, period, and work. Upload compressed file to think **AFTER** I have approved it.

**Grading:** Each category is worth 5 points. Your score will be based upon the grade you receive in each category.

"All About Me" is your home page and should have: an attractive background or picture, your picture (optional), and links to favorite websites - **you do not need to** include logos on it. **CITE SOURCES!!!** Link following files:

- Journals (copy from think or edmodo to a Word document; make sure to include some with political cartoons)
- First 6-Weeks Projects - Unit 1: Concepts (including, but not limited to):
  - Resume.doc (include Web Mastering skills learned including HTML and JavaScript)
  - This is Me.ppt (4 slides, add transitions)
  - Drawings. pub
- Second 6-Weeks Projects - Unit 2: FrontPage Basics (including, but not limited to):
  - Funny Voices, Inc. (make sure your site homepage tells customers that your company specializes in voice recordings and that you include an order form)
  - Music Order Form
- Third 6-Weeks Projects - Unit 3: HTML (including, but not limited to):
  - Favorite Web Sites (this will be on the homepage, All About Me)
  - Create a Photo Album
  - Planets (cite sources)
  - Self-Portrait (see instructions on Edmodo; can be used in place of a picture of yourself)
  - Heart (cite sources) should include a form that is interactive by adding JavaScript
- Fourth 6-Weeks Projects - Unit 4: Design (including, but not limited to):
  - Web Graphics
    - Art Show
    - Photo Editing Projects (name, color editing, etc.)
  - Clip Art website
  - Texas Spice Company
- Fifth 6-Weeks Projects - Unit 5: Scripting (including, but not limited to):
  - Create a pop-up and re-direct to your favorite Web site
  - Registration Form (you created)
  - Swap button/rollover
  - Weights (added to Planets Web site)
  - Search (added to All About Me)
- Sixth 6-Weeks Projects - Unit 6: Hosting and Maintenance
  - Create a web site for a real or imaginary business
  - "I am" Poem PowerPoint (add transitions)

Your electronic portfolio should include projects that are completed by YOU. These should be projects that you can show prospective schools or employers. I am looking forward to grading and sharing your portfolios.
