Dear Family,

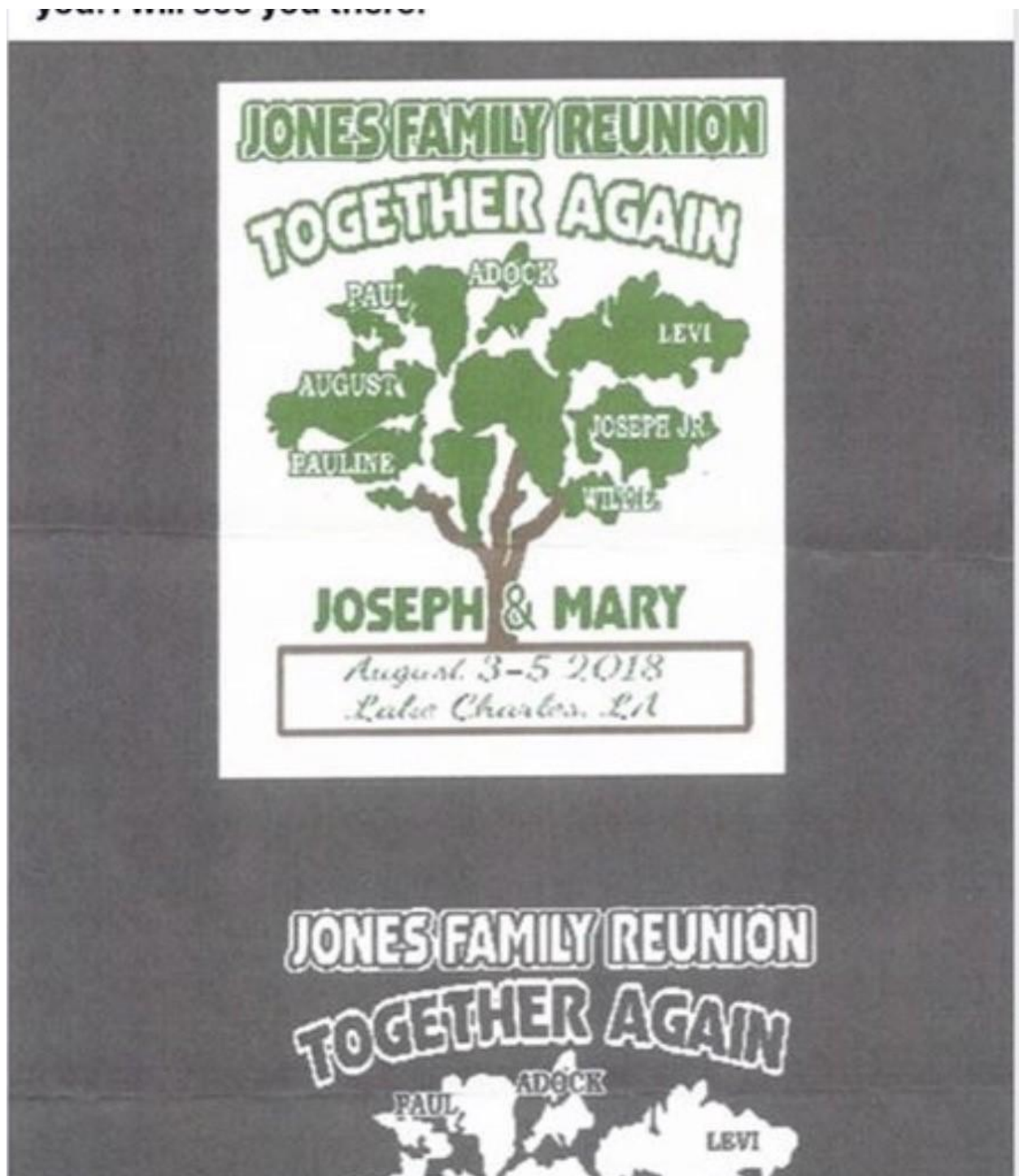

She was apparently sold twice. 1<sup>st</sup> sale with her Daughter Louise, 21 Jul 1783. The second sale with her husband 24 June 1803. His name is not listed.

These documents are chilling to read as they list the date, place, and value of the slave sale.

This is what I have discovered through Ancestry.com

**Marianne Nanette Laviolette** 5<sup>th</sup> great great great great Grandmother, was sold with her Daughter, **Lousie Laviolette**, 4<sup>th</sup> great great great Grandmother

**Lousie Laviolette** 4<sup>th</sup> married **Auger Oger Lavigne** 4<sup>th</sup> grandfather. I have not been able to locate the parents for **Auger Oger Lavigne** or **Auger** in **Census records**. **Their names were recorded by members of Ancestry**

Christoval and Eva married in 1905. But by the 1910 census, Christoval is listed as *widowed*—a detail that immediately struck me as odd. Why? Because there's no record of Eva (Maw) anywhere in the 1910 or 1920 census. She seems to vanish entirely during that time. Then, suddenly, she reappears in 1930 in Huntsville, Texas, married to Paw-Paw Dinkins.

You once told me that my great-grandfather, Christoval, disowned Maw because of Granddaddy Albert's dark complexion. That story stayed with me. And now, looking at the records, it seems that Christoval and Eva never legally divorced—yet he claimed to be widowed. With Maw disappearing for two decades, I can't help but wonder: was her version of the story true? Or did she leave Christoval, heartbroken, and abandon their child to be raised by her parents? Why didn't they divorce? What really happened?

Child... I have *so* many questions. This is starting to sound like the plot of a juicy Southern novel, and I just might have to write it. But I digress... Moving On

Here's what I *do* know: Eva had another child, Clinton Titus, born in 1911 in Boyce, Louisiana. His father was Phillip Titus. It appears she started a new life, possibly remarrying. Did Phillip know she was still married? Whatever happened between her and Christoval, it's clear that she left Granddaddy Albert behind, in the care of her parents. He appears in their household in both the 1910 and 1920 census records.

Maw's absence during those early years of Granddaddy's life has always puzzled me. Did she leave him out of necessity? Out of shame? Was it the only option she had, or the one she felt was best? She certainly was not in Opelousas in 1911; she was in Boyce. I don't yet have the full picture, but one thing's for sure: I'm determined to find it. It feels like my doctoral studies have brought me to this very moment—Dr. Dede is officially on a mission!

I'm also searching for her other son, William (Bill) Titus. So far, I haven't been able to trace him in any Ancestry records. As it stands, it seems that Granddaddy Albert was Christoval's only biological child. No DNA matches have surfaced from Christoval's side, and later census records show him listing only stepchildren. I often wondered if Christoval ever knew that his only son went on to give him *twelve* grandchildren.

Christoval eventually moved to Lake Charles, Louisiana, with his wife, while the rest of his family's story continued unfolding there. I have not located his burial records, but I have located his wife's.

Next up on my list is Maw's lineage—tracing the *Thomas* and *Brady* families. Maw is an enigma, a woman wrapped in layers of mystery and quiet strength. The more I discover, the more complex, fascinating, and compelling her story becomes.

As for the *Lavigne* lineage? I'm deeply fascinated by it as well. Some family researchers have traced our lineage back to the 1500s—that's roughly fifteen generations. What a discovery that is going to be, if true! I'm cautious, though. I won't include anything until I've verified it myself. I feel confident about Marianne, but there are conflicting accounts about her parents, and I want to be sure I get it right.

This journey isn't just about finding names and dates—it's about reclaiming stories, honoring truths, and giving voice to the silences in our family tree. The past is calling, and I'm listening.

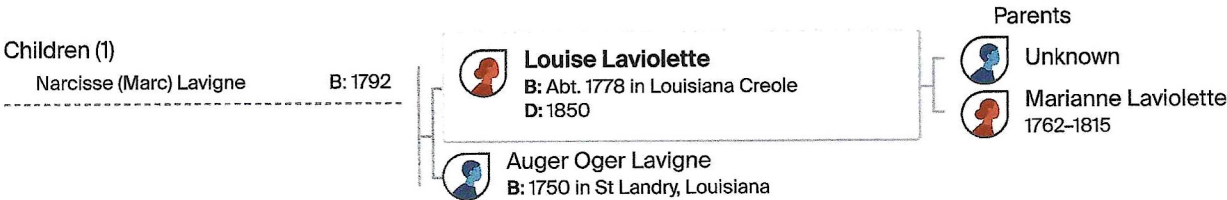

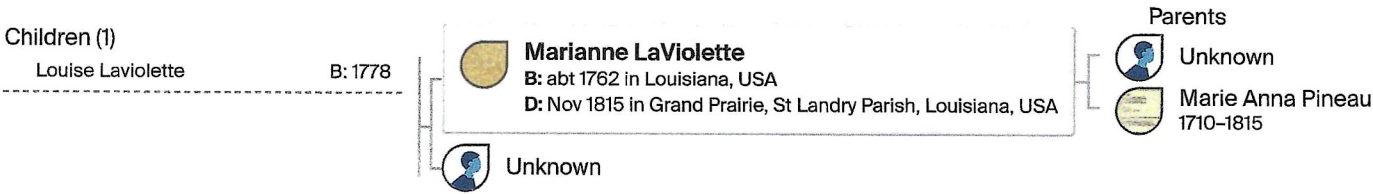

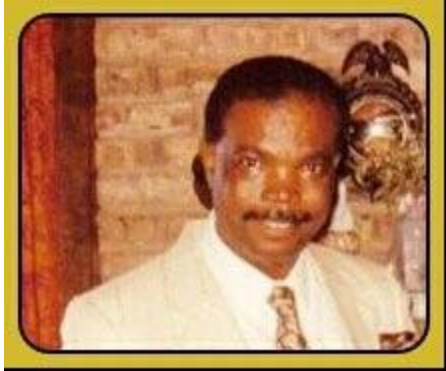

April 5, 2008 was the darkest day I remember. The sky was dark, the wind was still, and the clouds gave off as if a storm was coming. That afternoon my mother called me, I could hear the sorrow building up in her voice, like a blues song being created, when she told me my grandmother was dead. I couldn't speak. I felt a rush of pain and sorrow as if death itself was surrounding me. To me nothing else mattered the foundation of my family was gone. My spiritual guidance was no longer a call away. Many memories immediately flooded my mind as I began to reflect back to early times spent with my grandmother.

The rich smell of hazelnut fills the room waking me up at my grandparents' house. The short walk on the cold ceramic tile floor from the bedroom to the box-sized bathroom always woke me up completely. After a quick morning ritual in the bathroom, I follow the coffee aroma that leads me down the hallway. The closer I got to the living room the louder the news seemed. Grandmama would always be seated on the end of the white leather three-seated couch closest to the 72 inch screen television catching up on her current events. Past her, on the bar that was behind the white leather love seat, mail sat neatly in the corner. Finally, in the warm colored, handcrafted to her desire kitchen, I find golden croissants with fluffy eggs. I sit at the table where my grandmother's old bible would always be laid open to a new scripture. "Have we not taught you any manners?" Grandmama's soft, stern, rhythmic voice interrupted my thoughts. I smiled as I collected my manners and greeted her properly with a kiss on her warm, rose blushed, chubby cheek.

"We're here!" With a deep sigh, my mother exaggerates her relief after a two-hour drive to my grandparent's house in Houston. Sunny, without a cloud in sight. I ran through the garage, that never worked, past the huge 8 feet deep pool, that was never cleaned because they were scared the grandchildren would drown, to be hit by a rush of delicious smells of rice dressing, macaroni casserole, mustard-collard greens cooked with pork bones for extra flavor, and smoked turkey. The thought of going to the bathroom ended by the glare Grandmama gave me which was my warning to stop running. It always seemed like looking into the jungle when looking at Grandmama's attire. Grandmama's cheetah print shirt was coordinated well with her gold accessories that matched her shoes as well. PawPaw would always be sitting at the head of the gold-stained table, that was decorated by the season, reading his paper in dining room. Dining room was bigger than an average sized room. One side of the room had the table, where my grandfather would be seated and the other side was a smaller version of the living room but had a light blue color scheme. It was decorated

with elegant end tables that had deep engraved vines with beautiful white and gold lamps one each table. Normally during Christmastime, a white fully decorated Christmas tree with colorful streamers would be in the center across from the couch loaded with colorful wrapped boxes under the tree anticipating little children to open them. Once all my mother's siblings and their families arrived, we all would gather in the circle and hold hands to bless the food. Grandmama would be the one to start the prayer by saying, "Lord we thank you for family," and from there, PawPaw would pray a powerful heart-felt rhythmic prayer. And then we would eat.

Grandmama had poise in many difficult situations others would freak out about. I could recall a story I was told when I got older, a stranger, who resembled my grandfather, appeared at their home demanding to meet his father. Grandmama didn't fuss, fight, nor "go live," instead she opened the door and accepted him as though he was her own. In spite of how the situation happened, she never spoke negative words toward my grandfather; in fact, she prayed and stood firm in God's word.

I never knew how beautiful Grandmama's eyes were until she was laying in her death bed. When she was in the hospital, I couldn't stomach seeing her lie helplessly on the medical bed wired up like a car waiting to be cranked back to life. Instead, I avoided it because in my heart I knew it was temporary. Grandmama always taught us faith so I had faith that God was going to heal her, but things went from bad to worse quickly. The doctors finally decided to put her in Hospice care and sent her to, what I feel, die at home. Saturday visits to check on Grandmama quickly turned into a daily thing. One day, I wanted to talk to her so bad and hear her voice. I sat on her big comfy bed which was next to the hospital bed they placed in her room. I realized Grandmama had grey eyes, like a cat, that sparkled when she looked me into my eyes as she spoke words from the Bible, "Trust in Him with all thy heart and lean not to thy own understanding." I clutched her soft hands and let the tears hit the floor. I didn't want her to see me cry, but I wasn't her. I couldn't play strong anymore.

Even though Grandmama had breast cancer, it never stopped her from doing what she wanted to do. In fact, she encouraged me to do whatever my heart desired and constantly reminded me that our family was of royalty. Grandmama taught us to be virtuous and Godly. Her morals and teachings will always be engraved in our hearts and our life patterns. The last thing I remember about that horrid day, when the Hospice nurse pronounced her dead, the skies, literally, grew clear. It was as if God, Himself, was sending comforting words to my family saying "everything will be okay" because His angel has returned home. Pain free.
